

Death of Professor Petr Semeniuk



On Saturday, 21 February, Professor Petr Semeniuk died after a long illness. He was 75 years old. He was one of the most significant personalities of not only the Czech Anglers Union, where he performed many functions and where, between 2002 and 2010 he was the President. He will also be remembered in the history of European sports and recreational angling. He contributed to the deeper development of co-operation between angling unions from the countries of the so-called Visegrad Group, which was the base for the foundation of the European Anglers Federation.
